

EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

Emergency Proclamation by the Mayor of the City of Washington, Washington County, Pennsylvania pursuant to §11203 of the Third-Class City Code declaring a State of Emergency within the City limits of the City of Washington, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11203, Subparagraph (d) gives the authority to the Mayor of the City of Washington to issue a proclamation declaring a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Washington has determined that due to the extraordinary rainfall and weather conditions the residents and general public in the City of Washington are being subjected to potential harm to their person and property.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor of the City of Washington, pursuant to §11203 of the Third Class City Code hereby declares a State of Emergency for all areas within the City limits of the City of Washington, Washington County, Pennsylvania. Furthermore, the emergency powers granted by §11203, Subparagraph (e) of the Third-Class City Code shall be in full force and effect for the next five (5) days within the City limits of the City of Washington on a twenty-four (24) hour basis or unless extended by the City Council of the City of Washington, Washington County, Pennsylvania.
